Bob, This is an ongoing issue that staff have been involved with. The major issue appears to be how they will deal with the number of boat slips.

It is accurate that we can find no evidence of ordinance review since 1994. DNR statutory responsibilities are in 103F.221 and consist of a review and notification to the city if their ordinance or amendments do not substantially comply with the state standards. They could make changes that are more restrictive, but making changes that are less restrictive would result in a notification to bring them into compliance. Any changes should be sent to DNR for review.
