## **APPENDIX A**

### **FRANCHISE ORDINANCES (NOT CODIFIED)**

(Adopted 5/23/1996)
- Ordinance No. 188      An ordinance granting to Minnesota Power, Inc., its successors and assigns, the right to construct and maintain an electric distribution and transmission system within the City of Pequot Lakes, Minnesota. (Adopted 6/13/2001)
- Ordinance No. 159      An ordinance granting to Northern States Power Company, a Minnesota Corporation, a non-exclusive franchise to erect a gas distribution system. (Adopted 4/18/1994)
